- ✓ Your transcript will need to be sent to each college you apply to. Inform Mrs. DeVisser where you need your transcript sent.
- ✓ Some applications require recommendations from a teacher, principal, or counselor.
- ✓ Apply to a number of colleges and make your final decision later.

## FINANCIAL AID

✓ FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). All students intending to go to college should submit the application beginning October 1. Michigan has an application deadline of March 1. Apply as soon as possible at fafsa.ed.gov.

- ✓ VISIT COLLEGES Examine the place you are going! This is by far the best way to see what each college offers.
- ✓ GVSU the application deadline date for Grand Valley is December 31, 2020 and they are waiving the \$30 application fee! The scholarship deadline has been extended to July 31 this means you can still submit a revised transcript after 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> semester if your cumulative GPA increased enough to make you eligible for a higher scholarship. Or, if you take or retake the SAT or ACT and score higher than a previous test, you could become eligible for a larger scholarship.
- ✓ GRCC Job Training Programs GRCC offers eight Job Training programs. These are non-credit programs that run 18-22 weeks and students attend classes for 34 hour per week. Once a student has completed their program, they are ready to work! For a list of programs visit grcc.edu/jobtraining.
